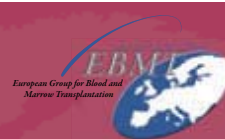

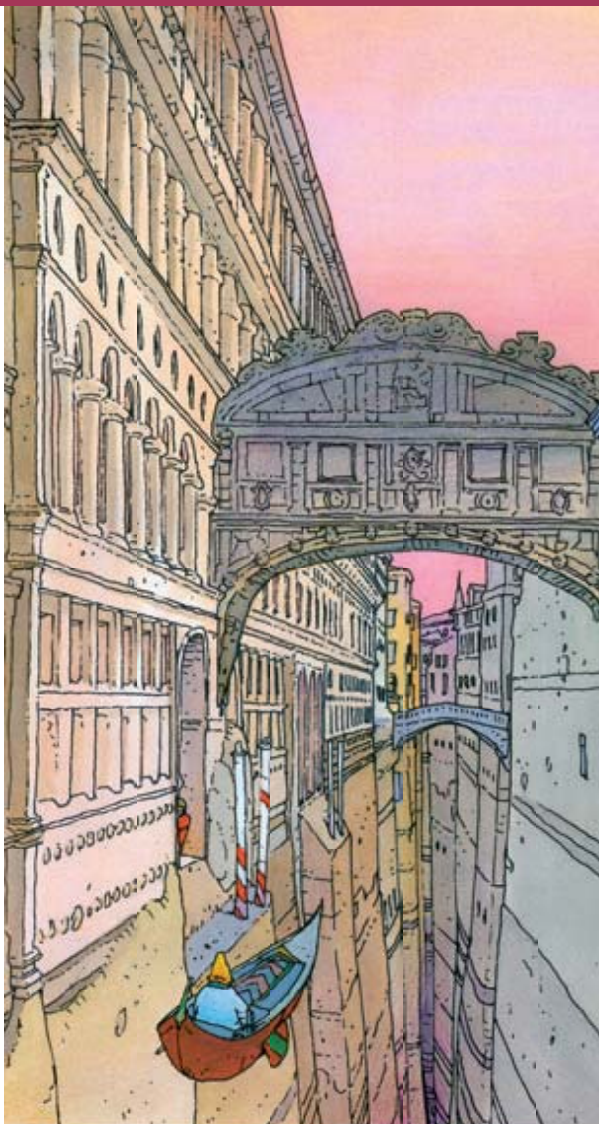
**16:00 Conclusions**

The 4th edition of the International Autologous and Allogeneic Cell Therapy for Solid Tumors (ATST) meeting will focus on novel cellular and antibody-based approaches to treat advanced solid tumors.

World-renowned experts in the field of cellular and antibody-based tumor immunobiology and autologous/allogeneic transplantation will discuss novel methods to potentiate immunity against cancer. The meeting will be divided into multiple sessions addressing novel monoclonal antibodies, immunotoxin- and radio-immunoconjugate therapies for cancer, vaccine therapies, and novel methods to augment NK-cell and T-cell based antitumor immunity. The meeting will also include sessions updating autologous and allogeneic transplants for solid tumors, as well as methods to enhance graft-vs-tumor effects utilizing tumor antigen specific T-cells, alloreactive NK cells, and post-transplant tumor vaccine approaches.
